Activity Name: Hot and Cold Sorting

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Sorts Objects
    - The child sorts and groups different objects together
  - Making Comparisons
    - Identifies differences, identifies similarities
  - Relates to adults
    - Works on complex projects with familiar adults
- Instructions
  1. Print and cut apart the images on the attached activity page. If a printer is not accessible you can always draw your own images or just talk about the objects.
  2. Once cut, have the child sort the pictures into two categories: hot weather and cold weather. Discuss why these things/activities belong in the category. "A snowman would melt in the hot summer sun"
  3. Watch the read aloud once more. Can you think of any other activities or objects in the story that could be added to either category?
- Extension Activity Ideas
  - Sort your own objects! Find toy cars and sort by color, grab some coins and sort by size, sort or group your stuffed animals by size or animal.

- Discuss the similarities and differences between the groups you created.
