Questions asked during Reading:

- We noticed on page 1 that Llama was going shopping with his mom! Do you ever go shopping with your mom and dad?
- What special day do you think Llama is waiting for on page 3? We will have to look for more clues and find out later!
- What gift do you think Llama will get? Wooden blocks or a tractor truck? (page 7)
- Did you ever bring cookies to school? I know I did! I brought cookies for everyone in my class for my birthday! (page 10)
- Do you ever get a tummy-ache when you eat a lot of cookies? I know when I eat a lot of cookies, my tummy gets really full! (page 11)
- Do you know what month it is shown on page 13? It looks like it is the month of December! Do you remember what one of the special holidays in December is?
- On page 17, we notice that Llama seems a little anxious for the holidays. I wonder what holiday he is waiting for!
- On page 18, did you notice any rhymes? I did! I noticed that the word “up” rhymes with “cup” and the word “floor” rhymes with “more.”
- On pages 22 and 23, we notice that Llama looks really tired from decorating! Do you ever get tired during the holidays? I know I do!
- Llama hugs his mama on this page. Can you give your mom a nice warm hug? (page 28-29)
- At the end of the story, did you figure out what holiday Llama was waiting for? On the final page, we notice that his stocking hanging from his bed is full of candy canes and shows the colors red and green.
 - That’s right! Llama was getting ready for Christmas!
