- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Makes comparisons Children are asked to compare the different pigs based on their size.
 - sorts objects children have to separate each pig into a different size category and then, they're asked to color the pigs with the correlating size color. Ex. The smallest pig is colored red.
 - plans complex activity
- Instructions
 - 1. Color the SMALLEST sized pig RED
 - 2. Color the MEDIUM sized pig BLUE
 - 3. Color the LARGEST sized pig PINK
 - 4. Refer to example on page #3 if you are struggling with differentiating the sizes of pigs
 - 5. When the pigs are colored based on their size correlation, number the pigs 1-3. 1 = smallest, 2 = medium, 3 = largest, Put the number somewhere on the pig.
 - 6. When you are finished, show one parent or guardian your awesome work!
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - Children could cut out the pigs and place them in order from largest to smallest

 Parents or guardians could go online and find pictures of different animals and have their children compare realistic sizes of different animals. Ex. an elephant's size versus a dog's size.
