Supplies for activities needed:

- Paper plate
 - **if you don't have a paper plate you can cut out a piece of paper the size of a plate
- Activity printable
- Scissors
- Markers
- Glue

Activity Name: Let's Build A Clock

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Places objects in sequential order
 - Initiating interaction with familiar adults
 - Following simple directions
- Instructions
 1. Use the clock at the end of the read aloud as a guide to help build your clock!



2. Cut out the numbers 1-12 provided in the activity printable and place them in a line in the correct order
 3. Glue the numbers 1-12 around the perimeter of your paper plate or paper circle. Use the picture above to help you know where to put the numbers.
 4. Cut out the short and long arrow from the activity printable
 5. Glue the long arrow and short arrow in the center of your clock. Ask someone who is by you to help adjust the arrows to show the current time. Also, ask them what the short arrow represents and what the long arrow represents.
 6. Decorate your clock with markers

 - Concept of time
 - Draw something that you did yesterday

 - Draw something that you did this morning

 - Draw something that you want to do tomorrow
