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Supplies for activities needed:

- Crayons
- Scissors
- Print out (rhyming)
- Print out (sharing)
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Activity Name: Rhyming and Matching

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Beginning Reading – Identifying some letters and numbers
 - Recognizes and makes rhymes
 - Plans Complex Activities – joins in with others to carry out complex and sequenced events
- Instructions
 1. Cut out each rhyming card
 2. Mix them up!
 3. Match up the rhyming cards
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - Ask the child to find other words that rhyme. Having a rhyming scavenger hunt in their bedroom or another room in the house is a great way to encourage practicing rhyming.
 - Lay the rhyming cards face down in front of you. Play a game of rhyming memory, taking turns flipping cards one by one until you can find a match.

Activity Name: Fruit Sharing

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Beginning Reading – Identifying some letters and numbers
 - Negotiates Social Conflicts – participates in sharing materials

- Plans Complex Activities – joins in with others to carry out complex and sequenced events
- Instructions
 1. Color the fruit according the color by number guide.
 2. Cut out each piece of fruit.
 3. As you watch the read aloud recording, have the child share the fruit with you or another person just like Oliver Tolliver does in the book.
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - Talk about similarities and differences of each fruit.
 - Child can help set the table and make sure everyone gets one of each type of food or tableware.
