

Book title: *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom*

Supplies for activities needed:

- Blank piece of paper
- Coloring utensil
- Alphabet beads
- Device that can connect to the internet (phone, computer, iPad, etc.)

Activity Name: Chicka Chicka Boom Boom Act Along

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Following multistep or complex directions
 - Shows interest when a book is read aloud
 - Identifying letters in the alphabet
 - Showing interest in simple use of materials/activities.
- Instructions
 1. With the coloring utensils, draw a big tree in the center of the blank piece of paper.
 2. Dump alphabet beads in a pile next to the paper with the colored beads. *(With younger children, adults may want to help organize the beads A-Z)*
 3. Pull up the *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom* read aloud on an electronic device.
 4. With the story, have the child move the corresponding letters up their tree.
 5. When the letters fall off the tree in the book, lift the piece of paper, letting the beads fall off the page.



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
