Supplies for activities needed:

- Scissors
- Construction Paper
- An open area (either inside or outside)
- Or if you do not have these materials, use your environment



Activity Name:

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Following simple directions
  - Identifying similarities between objects using a comparison word
  - The child groups similar items together
- Instructions

1. Start by taking the construction paper and cutting them into circles. (You can make them into different sizes to help prompt the child to do certain activities with them)



2. Take the circles you cut out and spread them all around your open area (in the living room, outside, bedroom)



3. Prompt the child to “go to all of the red dots” or place all of the blue dots in a pile” or “which two circles are the same shape”. This helps your child practice listening skills and gross motor skills.



4. You can use your environment to do this! It doesn't have to be paper, you can use different colored legos, dominoes, go to a playground etc
- Extension Activity Ideas
    - Have the child grab a sheet of paper and while you are reading the book, have them copy down that they see on the page. This can help them with counting and colors.
    - Example: “Copy down what you see on this page, when you are done tell me what colors you see and how many yellow dots are on the page.
    - Another prompt you can do is have your child follow the book while doing the activity, they could go to all of the yellow dots to count how many were on the page. This way you have a fun and interactive way to read the book.
