Questions asked during Reading:

- On the cover page, we noticed that the goose looks like she is on a mission! What do you think will happen in the story today?
- Wow! Look at that goose go! Have you ever seen a goose on a scooter? I sure haven't!(pg 3)
- Did you notice any words that rhyme with “day” and “bay?” (pg 3)
 - Ex: “stay,” “play,” and “way”
- Oh no! What happened to Ted? (pg 7)
 - The goose scooted through Ted and his flowers. His flowers went everywhere! Was that very nice of Goose to do that? No, that was not very nice.
- Can you think of any more words that rhyme with “zoo,” “moo,” and “coo?” (pgs 10-11)
 - I can think of “you,” “two,” and “new!”
- What do you think all of the animals are going to do with Goose? (pgs 14-15)
- Oh no, silly Goose! She is swimming in the penguin pool! (pg 16)
 - Can you think of any more words that rhyme with “fool” and “pool”? Some examples I thought of are “tool” and “cool.”
