Activity Name: Friendly Communication

- Instructions
  - 1. Play the game you've decided on, or with the toys you have out.
  - 2. When you start to play with something new, ask your friend if it's okay for you to do that.
    - a. "Is it okay if I play with trucks for a little while? I'm tired of blocks."
  - 3. If they do something that upsets you, use your words to tell them that it upsets you.
    - a. "It really upset me that you took my blocks, can you ask next time?"
  - 4. Or, if they do something that you really liked, tell them!
    - a. "I really liked when you asked me to build a block tower with you! Let's do that again."
