Activity Name: Ten Pigs and One Kid

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Able to identify sequence in an activity or story
- Instructions
  1. Choose something you like to do, some of the pigs liked to build sandcastles, pretend to be a pirate, go fishing, or go surfing.
  2. Draw yourself getting ready to get in the bathtub with the other pigs, but before the wolf comes.
  3. Think about what you would be bringing with you into the bathtub. For example, if you wanted to pretend you were at the beach, you might wear sunglasses and bring a towel.
- Extension Activity Ideas
  - Draw as many pigs as you can think of to join the first 10 pigs in the tub. Count each one, you might need more than just your fingers to count that many pigs.
  - What kinds of activities do the pigs you're drawing want to do in the bathtub?
